The Wednesday Evening Prayer & Bible study is now on its summer break until the fall. Watch the bulletin for the start up date.

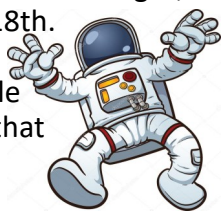
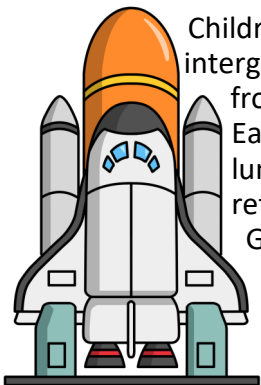
Missionary Evening with Tim & Kallie Hutton
